Crowning ceremony	Sunday 3 October at Macarthur Square Shopping Centre, Gilchrist Dr, Campbelltown

On crowning day each entrant and parent/guardian must arrive promptly at 1pm at the Macarthur Square Centre Court and report to the quest co-ordinator, Marie Rutledge.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. It is desirable for the entrants to have a good knowledge of the City of Campbelltown, Fred Fisher and the Festival of Fisher's Ghost.
2. Entrants must be between the ages of 9 and 12 as of Friday 10 September 2010.
3. An entry fee of \$20 (GST inclusive) is payable by each entrant to the cashiers at Campbelltown City Council.
4. Entrants will indemnify the Festival of Fisher's Ghost Sub Committee, Campbelltown City Council and sponsors of this event from legal action arising from the entrants' activities in the Quest.
5. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. All entrants must reside within the Campbelltown Local Government Area.
7. Quest categories are: Festival Princess, Festival Princess Runner Up and Highly Commended.
8. Any photographs taken by Council staff of the entrants may be used in promoting the Festival of Fisher's Ghost.
9. All entry forms must be submitted by hand to Campbelltown City Council together with the \$20 entry fee (GST inclusive) and a photograph of the participant (head and shoulder shot) by 4pm Friday 10 September. No extensions on this time or date will be given.
10. A guardian must be available on the dates listed at the top of this page to supervise the entrant at the judging, crowning and Street Parade. If the entrant participates in the Street Parade, a guardian must remain with the entrant at the drop off point prior to the parade, and meet the entrant at the collection point after the parade.
11. Entrants will follow a strict dress code. No high heels, shoestring straps or makeup are to be worn at any time. Clothing worn at both the judging and the crowning ceremony must be covering the shoulders.
